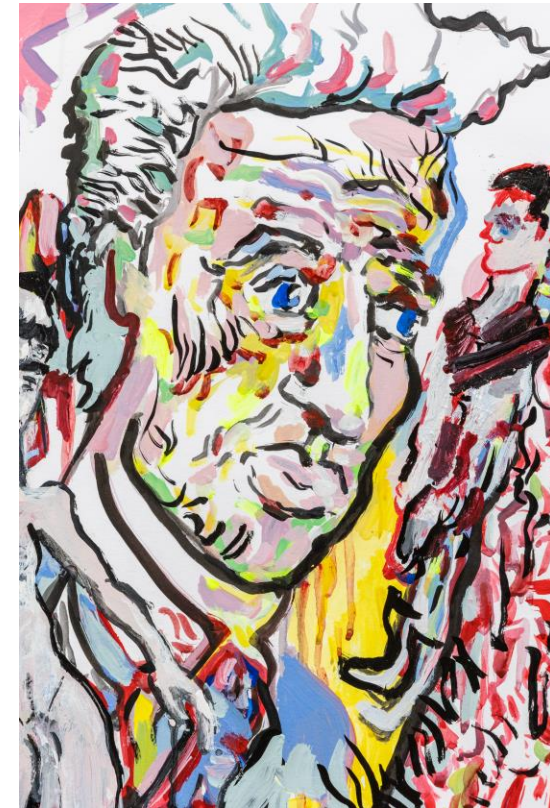


Rachid Ben Ali

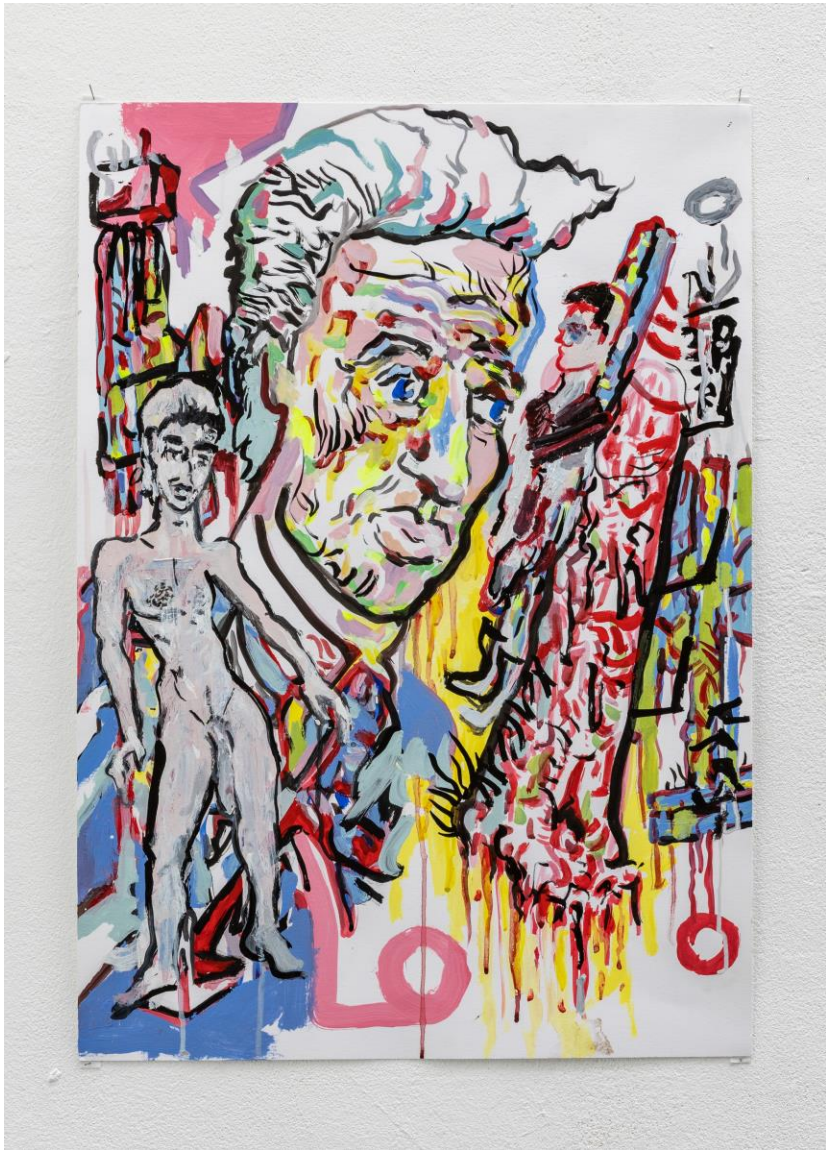

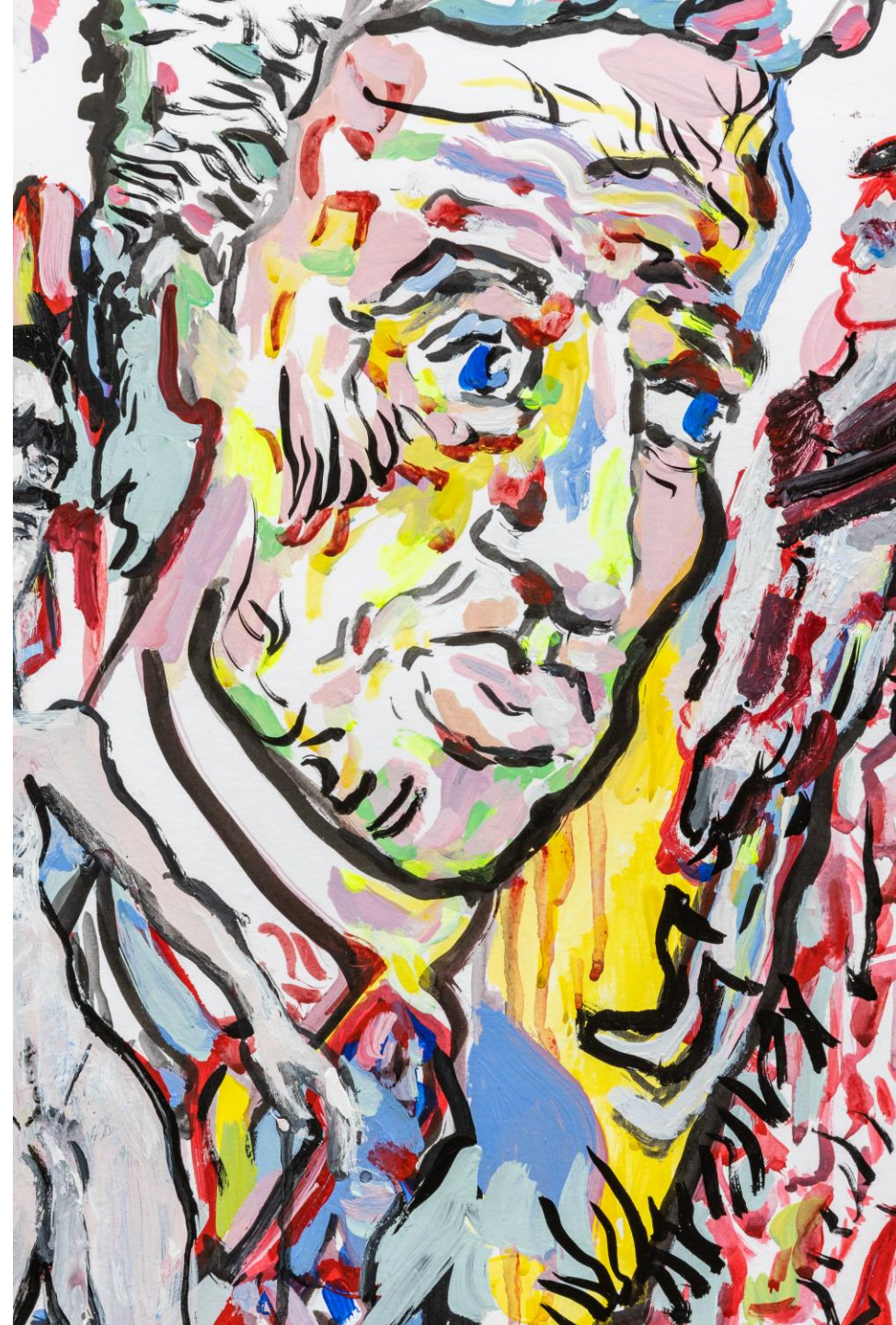


Rachid Ben Ali, detail, 2025



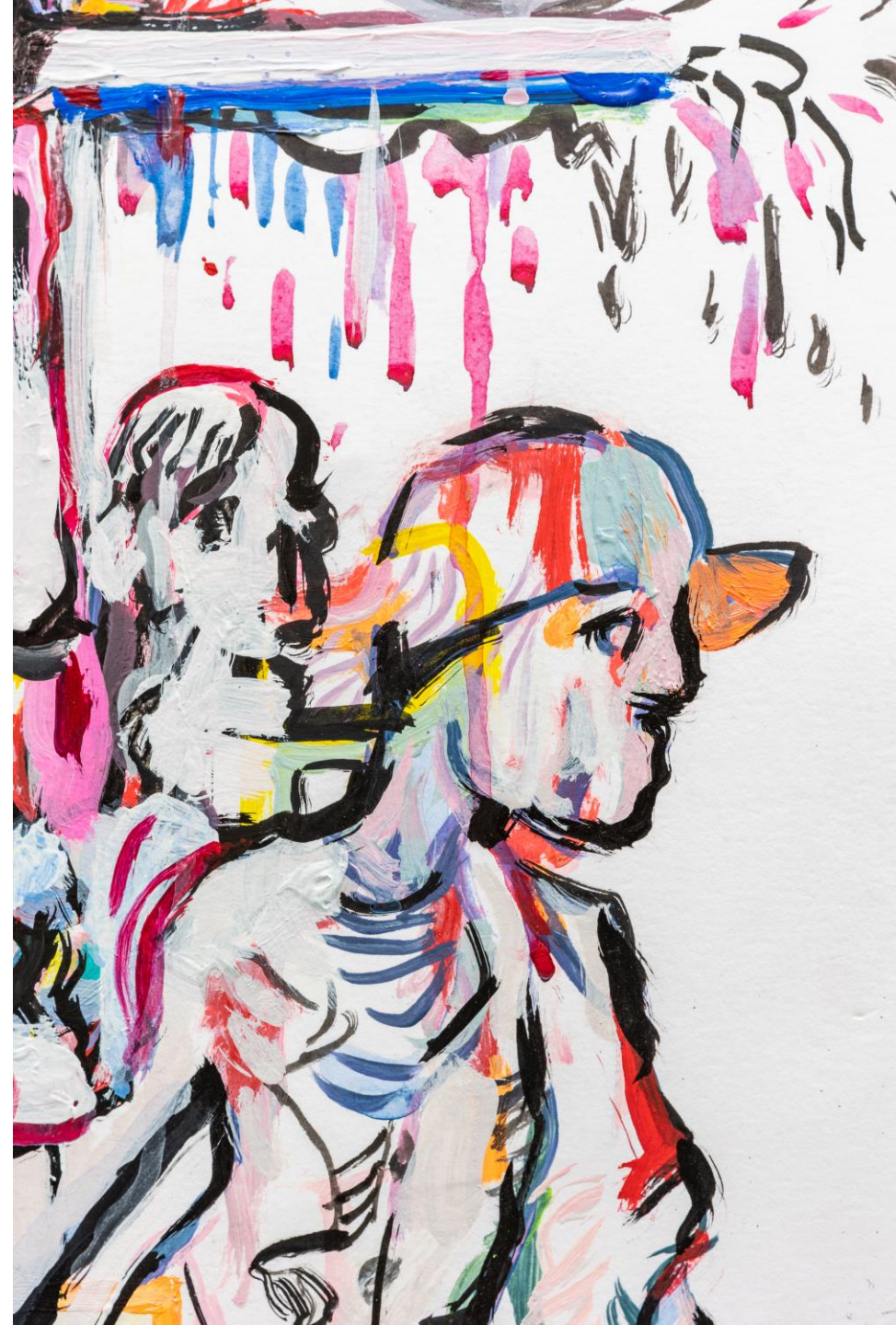

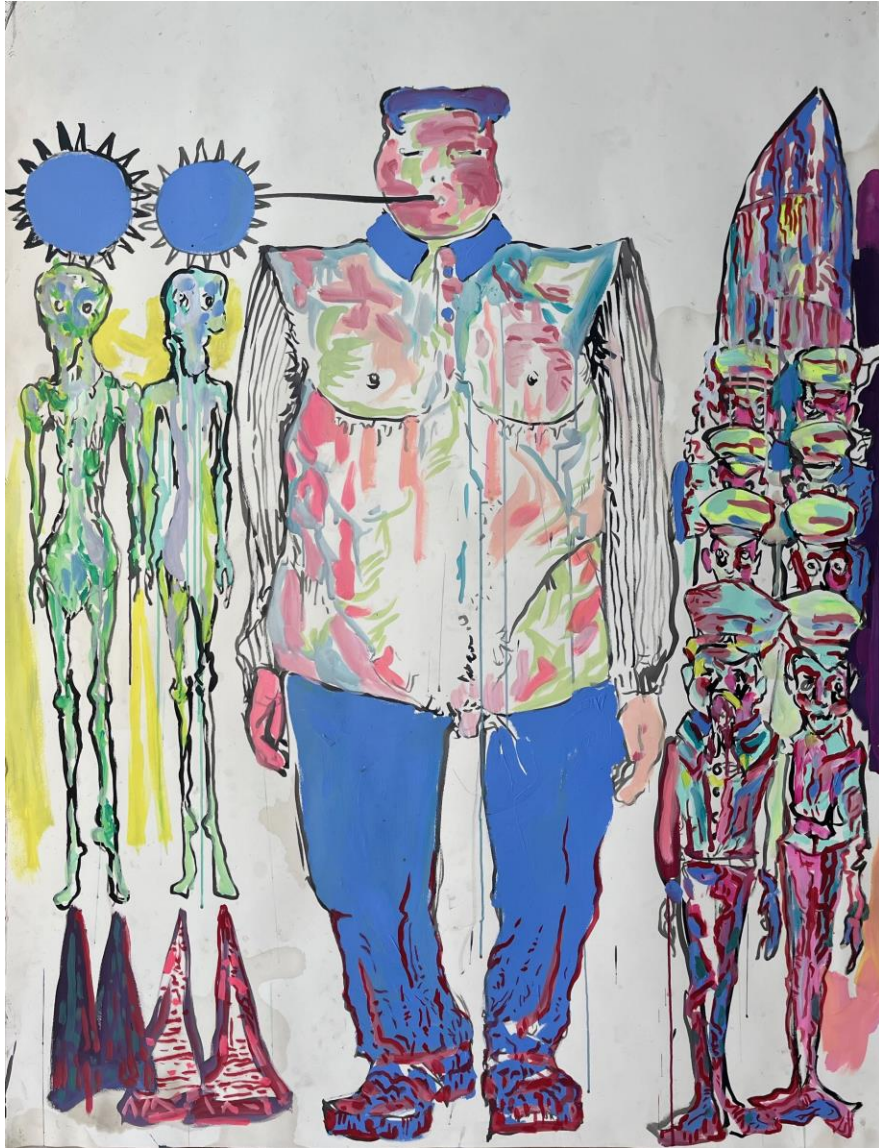

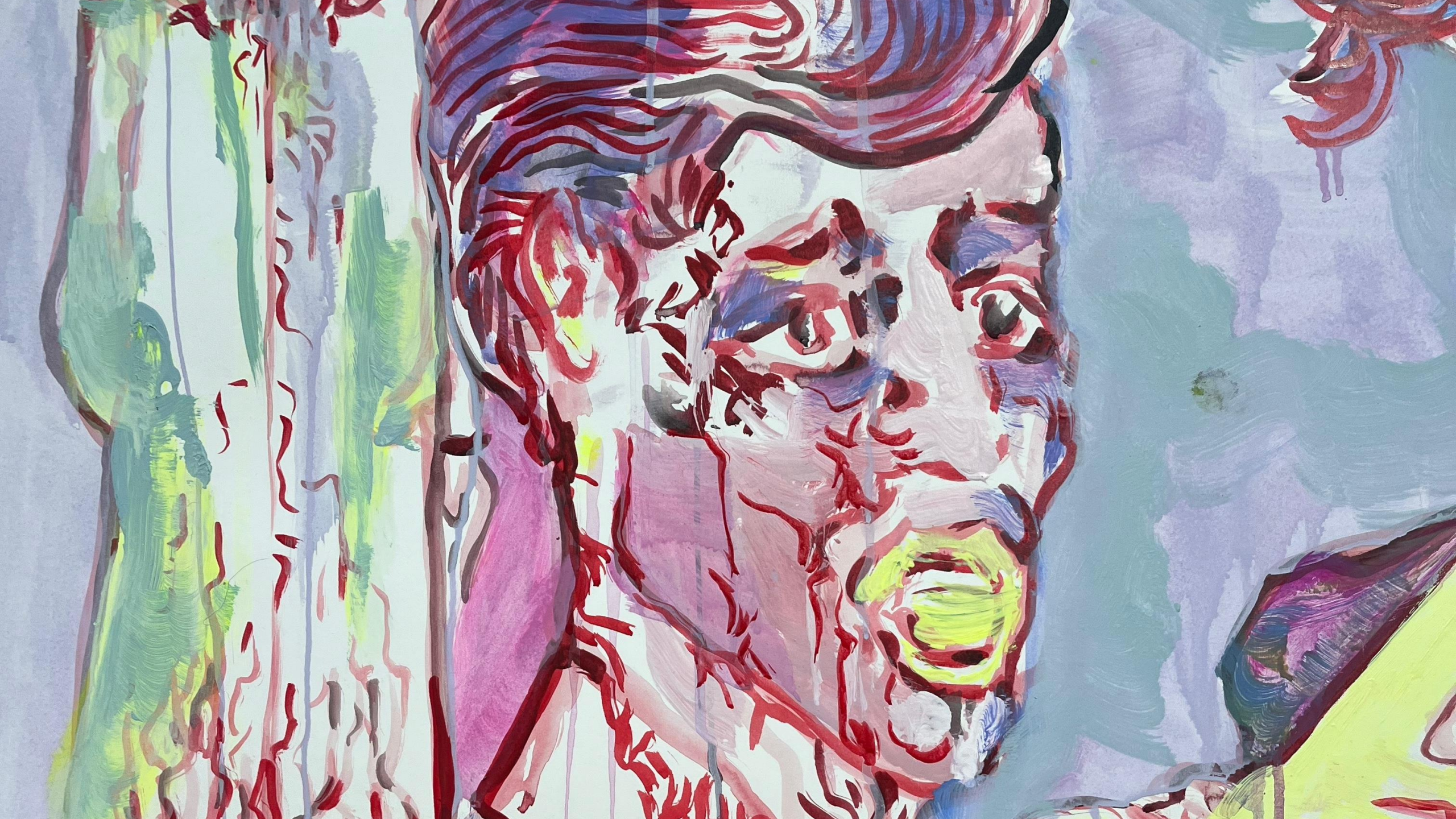

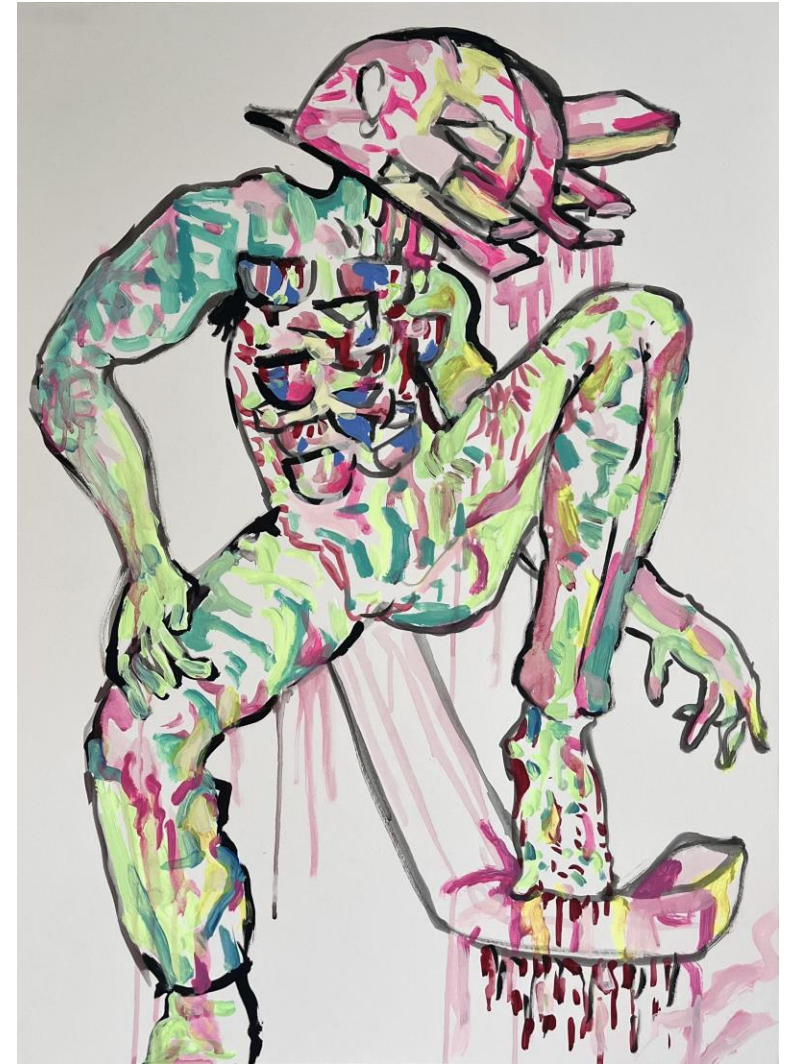

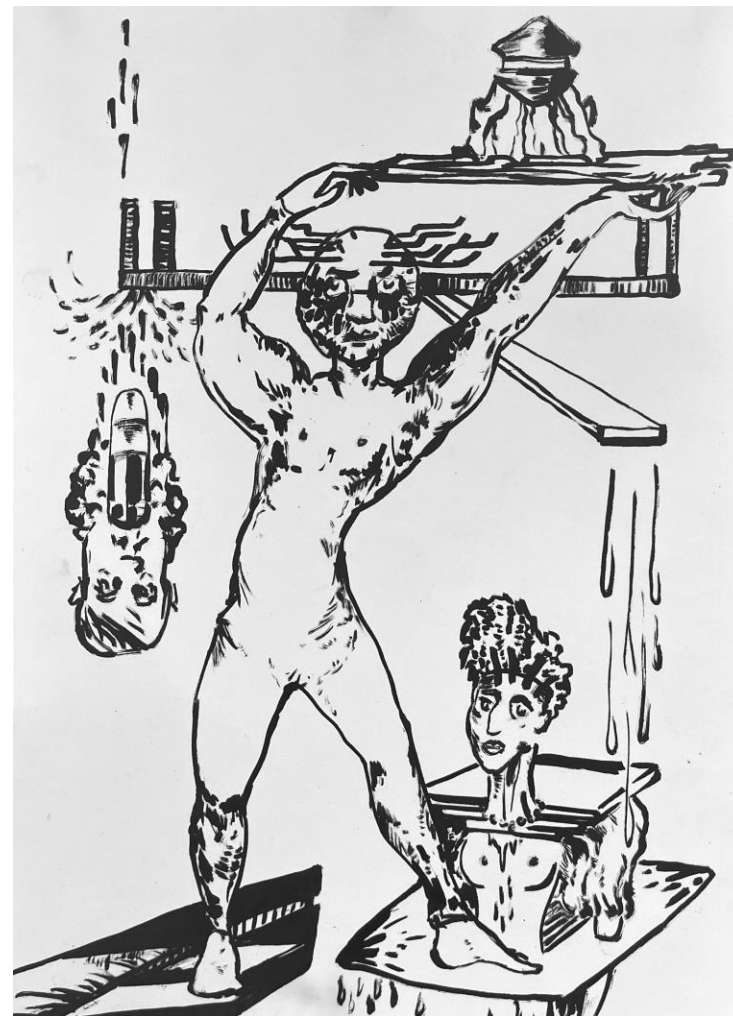
